Job Responsibilities

- Work closely with production personnel and engineers to prepare equipment preforming all functions related to the assembly process from picking component inventory through final assembly.
- Will be reading blueprints, process sheets, schematics, mechanical drawings, pictures and other diagrams to connect sub-assemblies used to assemble the final product.
- Receives work orders from the production manager and the sales department that determine components required for machine assembly.
- Assemble products with a focus on quality
- Inspect, test, and adjust completed units to ensure that units meet specifications and customer's order requirements.
- Record inspection data for each machine.
- Notify production manager of any unusual problems or concerns
- Utilize hand and power tools to perform necessary job duties.
- Must be able to obtain forklift certification (training on-site) and be able to operate overhead cranes
- Assist shipping department with loading of ocean containers for international shipping.
- Communicate with purchasing to maintain required inventory levels for manufacturing.
- Some customer contact is required during equipment demonstrations and service inquiries.
